- I. Call to Order – Sara Rosengren
Meeting called to order at 4:32

- II. Introduction of new members - members sign in and introduce themselves with name, position, and school.
No new members.

- III. Approval of January Minutes

Approved unanimously.

- IV. Superintendent's Report - John Scholl
the budget still hasn't been dropped at the legislature. There is some talk of four tenths of one percent in teacher salary increase. Next year's budget is based on next year's enrollment. We could be hiring or letting go in the middle of the year depending on enrollment. The big drain on budget this year is insurance. The loss ratio went down to about 111% from 120%. ASBAIT will raise rates. Prescott/Humboldt has their own trust; we gave them information and they'll let us know on the 21st if we can join their trust. They haven't had to raise their rates for three years in a row. Prescott Unified used to have their own trust, then they joined with Humboldt, and we are investigating if we can join too, to spread the risk over more people. By our meeting in March we should have more information.
We are entering the hiring season. There have been 6-7 resignations so far in the district for next year.
A few committees have been formed for screening and interviewing the principal candidates.
Certified contracts will go out the middle of April. Classified is on a January 1st cycle, work agreements are open ended and don't expire.
The Board gave preliminary approval on the county sub pool. Subs will be employees of Educational Services Inc. The district will not use AESOP any more.

- V. Looking at Undifferentiated Leave
Employees earn one hour for every 20 hours worked. The formula now encourages people to use their days. Discussion was engaged in about what to do about it, change it? Perhaps there needs to be incentive for people to hold on to their leave instead of burning it up. If a change is made, SEAC would make a recommendation to the board.

- VI. Family rates for entering sporting events
Pete Jelovic couldn't make it to discuss this issue. Table it for later or get answers in writing from him for discussion later.

- VII. Moving 2nd grade over to TECC
How can they move earlier and not have to move during the summer? Sodexo's new building is almost completed, by the end of the month. 4-5 rooms will be available then. Everything should be available except for 2 classrooms and with two new teachers being hired the existing teachers should be able to move before summer.

- VIII. New Issues to Discuss
Continue discussion on undifferentiated leave and continue discussion on family rates for entering sporting events.
There will be more answers for health insurance at the next meeting.
